Birding Arlington by Bike - April 28, 2018

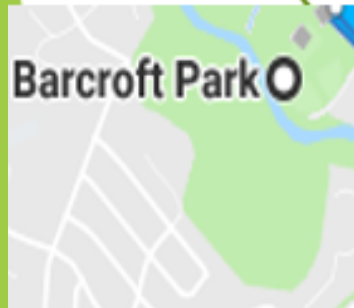
A 17-mile jaunt around Arlington's birding hotspots to enjoy the spring migration and see how many species we can observe. Novice birders are welcome.
