

Waycroft Woodlawn Neighborhood Tree Stroll

On Saturday, April 21st, there will be an informative and enjoyable "stroll" through the Waycroft Woodlawn neighborhood. The walk, which will be led by individuals from Arlington's Urban Forestry Commission, Tree Stewards, and Master Naturalists, will focus on neighborhood Notable Trees and locations of past years' Tree Canopy Fund trees to show how much they've grown (and to encourage future applicants)! Participants will also look for examples of mulching (proper vs. "volcano"), pruning needs, and other tree care details. A Master Naturalist will cover the wildlife values of highlighted trees. Another bonus: learn how you could duplicate this type walk in YOUR NEIGHBORHOOD!
