What is Book Share?

Participants are invited to provide a brief overview of a book or other material regarding Virginia's natural resources that they found inspiring and useful. Reviews and summaries are fitting, but please also consider sharing a fact, insight, or observation from the material that applies to the type of volunteer work that ARMN members do (sustaining local natural areas, environmental education related to our natural world, or citizen science activities in our community that contribute to greater knowledge of local streams, plants, animals, and local habitat).

Location: [Cafe Sazon](#), 4704 Columbia Pike, Arlington, VA 22204. It is next to the W&OD trail as well as the Columbia Pike bus lines and a bikeshare station. It is in the same strip mall as Goodwill. There is also nearby street parking on S. Buchanan. The restaurant features Latin American food, but also serves bakery options and alcohol.

Time: Arrive at 6:30 pm if you want to order dinner and chat. Arrive at 7 pm for the book share only. Tell staff that you are with the book club.

Answers to Frequently Asked Questions

You are welcome to participate even if you do not have something to share.

This is not a book discussion group where we all read and discuss the same material.

Magazines or journals (or specific articles) are fine too, as are apps, websites, or any resource that enhances your knowledge of Virginia's natural resources.

This is not a book swap. Feel free to bring books or magazines to give away or share if you wish, but that is optional.

Please consider what you can share about the book in less than 5 minutes. If there is adequate time, you can expound beyond that.

The book sharing portion counts as Continuing Education.
