

Fraser Preserve Barberry Removal

Help remove Japanese barberry at The Nature Conservancy's Fraser Preserve, located at the north end of Springvale Road in Great Falls. Bring heavy leather gloves, hand clippers, and garden forks, if possible. Also bring water and dress for off-trail work. We've been working there for years, and most of the barberry close to the entry is gone, so most times we'll be working from the camp: down a narrow & difficult gravel/dirt road extension of Springvale Road. Many prefer to meet at the gate & get a ride into the preserve, **so be sure to let Margaret know you're coming!**

Time: 10 am - 1 pm

Dates: Every weather-acceptable Wednesdays in January & February, but date may shift to correspond with better weather. **Contact Margaret to be sure!**

Location: Near corner of Springvale and Allenwood Roads in Great Falls, to the camp at Fraser Preserve (end of the gravel road).
